

Hilfswerk Österreich (Austria) in numbers

- Hilfswerk with its 7 regional organizations is one of the largest nonprofit organizations providing home care, social services, child care and support for families in Austria.
- Hilfswerk employs almost 10.000 people, around 20,000 members and volunteers support our organization.
- Budget of €295 million from public service contracts, customer contributions, donations and sponsoring
- 77,000 paying customers in 2017
- Our main fields are the care of
 - elderly and/or ill persons (mobile care for approx. 30.300 persons)
 - children and young people (approx. 7500 children with child minders; approx.
 10.000 children in day care centers and playgroups/children's groups).


